## REMOTE COMMUNITY WORKSHOP | 18 MAY

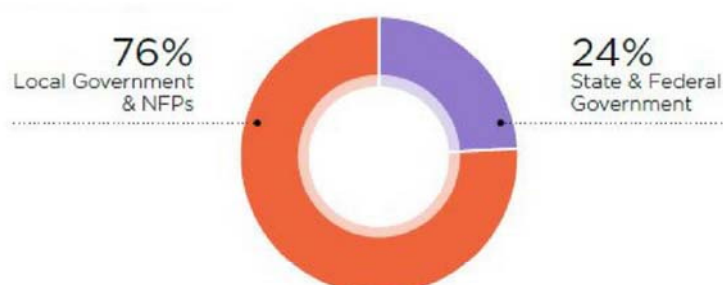
